


Did you know? Cord Blood OPTIONS

By deciding to donate or store your baby's umbilical cord blood and/or cord tissue, you and your baby may make a difference for a patient or family member suffering from cancer, leukemia, and many other diseases. Please see the basic guidelines below to learn more about making this very important life-changing decision. **Either donate,** privately store or participate in research but don't throw something so vital in the trash.



Basic Public Donation Information: (For Cord Blood)

Guidelines:

- You must be at least 18 years of age.
- You must be in general good health.
- You can NOT donate if you are expecting multiple births.
- You must be at least 34 weeks gestation.

Basic Private Banking Information:

There are NO guidelines to store your baby's cord blood, as it belongs to you.
